VII. NOAH'S FAITHFULNESS BENEFITTED ALL

God said, "This is the sign of the covenant which I am making between Me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all successive generations; Genesis 9:12

Noah's faith was a prophetic lesson for future generations.

For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and they did not understand until the flood came and took them all away; so will the coming of the Son of Man be. Then there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left.

"Therefore be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming. But be sure of this, that if the head of the house had known at what time of the night the thief was coming, he would have been on the alert and would not have allowed his house to be broken into. For this reason you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think He will.

MAIN IDEA: GOD'S COMMENTARY ON NOAH

By faith Noah, being warned by God about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world, and became an heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

Hebrews 11:7A

I. NOAH DESCENDED FROM A FAMILY OF ______

SETH

Adam had relations with his wife again; and she gave birth to a son, and named him Seth, for, she said, "God has appointed me another offspring in place of Abel, for Cain killed him." To Seth, to him also a son was born; and he called his name Enosh. Then men began to call upon the name of the LORD.

GENESIS 4:25-26

ENOCH

Then Enoch walked with God three hundred years after he became the father of Methuselah, and he had other sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

GENESIS 5:22-24

LAMECH

Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and became the father of a son. Now he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will give us rest from our work and from the toil of our hands arising from the ground which the LORD has cursed."

"Noah" To rest or bring rest – to comfort in sense of helpful. Lamech felt the burden of sin's curse on the earth and looked forward to the time of redemption.
