Believers _____ of God's activity in the community.

ACTS 2:43 *Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles.*

Believers _____ all they have with the community.

ACTS 2:44-45 *All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.*

Believers _____ regularly with others in the community.

ACTS 2:46-47a *Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people.*

God _____ to the community.

ACTS 2:47b *And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.*

How to Become a Christian

Many people believe they are Christians because they were born in a Christian culture, go to church regularly, try to do their best, or live a good life. However, the Bible teaches that these things cannot make you a Christian. You become a Christian by simply taking these two steps:

- Acknowledge that you (along with all people) have sinned and fallen short of God's standards. ROMANS 3:23
- Personally believe that Jesus Christ, who was God in human flesh, died for your sins on the cross and rose again. 1 CORINTHIANS 15:3, 4

You may express your belief through prayer, asking Jesus to come into your life, and receiving Him as God's gift to you.
